The BYMT Rock School welcomes students aged 13 - 18 years who wish to play in a Rock Band. Rock School is open to Vocalists, Guitarists, Bass Guitarists, Drummers and Keyboard Players who are at Grade 3 and above in their respective musical studies.

Sessions of Rock School are lead by professional tutors from each instrument with the emphasis on studying a particular song in instrument specific groups. The last hour at Rock School is spent performing that song in a full Rock Band setting.

Sessions will be held at The Ravensbourne School, Hayes Lane, Bromley. A concert will be held at the end of each term to which friends and parents will be welcome. It is very important that students attend all the sessions in any term and naturally, it is essential that all members attend the termly concert after which sessions cease for that term.
