

BYMT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. PAYMENT

Payment for services provided by BYMT must be made in full within the time frame specified on the Application Form. Parents/Carers experiencing difficulties may be able to pay in instalments or in the case of serious financial hardship may be entitled to financial assistance. Please contact the Office, any such enquiries will be treated in the strictest confidence.

2. BEHAVIOUR

We expect all students and parents/carers to:

- treat all members of BYMT staff, other students, parents and carers and members of the public with the utmost respect. Physical, verbal or electronic abuse or any disrespectful behaviour towards any member of the BYMT community (staff, students and parents/carers) will not be tolerated.

We expect all students to:

- attend all lessons and rehearsals punctually and regularly unless indisposed or given prior permission to be absent, in advance,
- practise regularly,
- try their best in all activities,
- take pride in their practice and work,
- keep their instruments, cases and personal belongings tidy,
- listen carefully to instructions in lessons and rehearsals,
- in rehearsals allow others to play or sing without distraction,
- sing or play co-operatively with other students,
- avoid any activity which might cause distress to another child, particularly in a way which would constitute bullying (see BYMT's *Anti-bullying Policy*),
- attend dress rehearsals on concert days as well as all concerts appropriate to each group,
- actively promote the good name of BYMT.

For persistent poor attitude, effort or behaviour, parents/carers will be contacted and the student's membership of BYMT reviewed. This may result in exclusion.

Serious breaches of behaviour, including during a tour, will be referred to the Principal and dealt with severely.
