As well as basic orchestral training which will be of great assistance to those who are ambitious to audition later for the Saturday Morning Centre, there will be technical games and exercises designed to increase instrumental awareness and control.

Rehearsals will be held at Bromley Youth Music Trust, Southborough Lane, Bromley. A concert will be held at the end of each term to which parents and friends will be welcome.

It is very important that children attend all the rehearsals in any term, and naturally it is essential that all members attend the termly concert after which rehearsals cease for that term.
